

PROFESSIONAL STAFF LICENSURE

Personnel employed by Waynesboro Public Schools in positions that require the holding of a license shall abide by the guidelines for renewing licenses provided to employees by the superintendent or designee.

License holders in the Commonwealth of Virginia will renew their license by acquiring renewal points accrued by completion of activities within designated options, passing scores for required assessments, and documentation of other required trainings or certifications outlined by the current adopted guidelines of the Virginia Department of Education's *Licensure Regulations for School Personnel*.

The employee is ultimately responsible for maintaining a license in force and for abiding by the appropriate guidelines.

Contracts are issued to professional employees based upon meeting current licensure requirements and/or eligibility for licensure by the Virginia Department of Education for the year the contract is in effect.

School Speech-Language Pathologists must hold current licensing by the Virginia Association of Health Professionals.
